Omar Kasmani is a post-doctoral Research Fellow in Social and Cultural Anthropology at the Collaborative Research Center *Affective Societies* at Freie Universität, Berlin. His work pursues ideas of be/longing, queer futurities, and the affects of intimacy in the interstices of religion and sexuality. He teaches queer theory and religion in South Asia and has co-edited the volume *Muslim Matter* (Revolver Publishing, 2016).
