



From The Series 'Black Hands White Earning' II, 2021 Charcoal on Canvas, 24 x 18 inches


















Desire of Freedom, 2021 Gouache on Wasli 18 x 13 inches






Intensity of Desire, 2021, Gouache on Wasli, 10.7 x 10.7 inches

















Before Night, 2021, Acrylic on Canvas, 36 x 36 inches









Aurat Ko Samajhna Mushkil Hai II, 2021, Gouache on Wasli, 18.4 x 10.7 inches




