
COGNITIVE CONSTRUCTS FAIZAN RIEDINGER

CURATOR'S NOTE

Moving beyond his known black and white works on canvas Faizan's third solo "Cognitive Constructs" consists of 26 artworks on canvas, three different types of wood and glass.

Through the the interplay of his gestural abstract calligraphy, muted colors and three dimensional forms, Riedinger prompts us to question the structures that influence our perception of self and others.

Meticulously cutting, painting, gluing and working on individual pieces of pine wood, Faizan has moved out of the two dimensional canvas in "Transitioning Stage 1,2 & 3".

Similarly, in "The Monolith" and "The Five Pillars" strips of balsa wood have been used to create a canvas on a canvas.

An ode to his "Expansion" series from his second solo in 2021, Faizan has also taken his experimentation on glass forward on a larger scale in the new series "Inner Light"

Staying true to his meditative style this show adds a new dimension to Faizans work as he explores thought, color and forms while serving as a testament to his journey an artist.




"COGNITIVE CONSTRUCTS"
















Rayleigh scattering, 2023 Ink, acrylic, pine wood on canvas 24 x 36 inches























ARTIST BIO

Faizan Riedinger (b. 1988, German, Pakistani)

Faizan Riedinger is a German-Pakistani visual artist and musician.He lives and works in Karachi, Pakistan. His work has featured in solo shows and collectives locally and internationally, and has been acquired and published by the Islamic Art Museum Malaysia in 2023.

Riedinger's art is rooted in his love for the Arabic alphabet and script. He works fastidiously and meticulously, using architect's pens on canvas to create calligraphic-inspired motifs that are minute and identical in size, and which combine to form geometric shapes, such as circles and semi circles, or patterns in linear form. Sometimes monochrome and on other occasions created in a combination of contrasting colours, the pieces have a calming, understated and hypnotic quality about them that aligns with their creator's artistic process.

Categorising his art is no easy task, but Riedinger thinks the phrase "hyper-minimalism" best describes it since, as he explains, "it looks minimal but once examined close up, is full of detail".

Riedinger finds satisfaction in the self-imposed limitations and restrictions that are a key part of the process in his art, although he is the first to admit that his way of working is as challenging as it is rewarding. "The elements have to be exact, which can be frustrating, and the nature of the way I work inevitably means it's highly repetitive," he acknowledges, "but when I step back and can see the work in its entirety, it's incredibly satisfying."
